**SUBJECT\*: Alpacas and Transported Stock Statements**

Dear Mr Richardson

I apologise for the delay in getting this reply to you and trust that you have time to inform your members before they have start transporting their alpaca to Canberra.

There is no requirement for Alpaca to be accompanied by a Transported Stock Statement during transport.

Part 10A of the Rural Lands Protection Act 1998 describes the requirements for the transport of stock by vehicle. Section 140A defines stock as cattle, sheep, goats and horses. Alpaca are not defined as stock for the purposes of the Travelling Stock Statement.
